ABOUT THE OFFICE OF RESEARCH

OR advances the research mission at UC Davis through its oversight of 21 research units, special research programs, and central facilities. OR employs over 1,100 academic and staff employees, and has annual expenditure and recharge income in excess of \$155 million. In addition, OR oversees 15 administrative units, the campus-wide Research Core Facilities Program, campus-wide research funding programs, and the Animal Use and Care Program.



The Associate Vice Chancellor (AVC) for Innovation and Technology Commercialization fosters university-industry relationships that are integral to the growth and impact of UC Davis research.

The AVC will identify current and emerging research strengths at UC Davis and establish innovative partnerships between the university and corporate partners, as an advocate for UC Davis' intellectual property.

The AVC's responsibilities include:

- Supporting the creation of UC Davis start-up companies
- Marketing UC Davis technologies to increase licenses and agreements
- Expanding the number, breadth and quality of industry-university research relationships – both foreign and domestic
- Enhancing campus awareness of corporate research and interactions
- Identifying potential sources of corporate support for emerging UC Davis initiatives
