The Research Ethics and Compliance Office (RECO) in the Office of Research at UC Davis has contracted with the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) to provide online training in Responsible Conduct of Research. (RCR) These online courses are designed for faculty and staff members, graduate students and undergraduate students who are interested in or focusing on the research areas listed below. The CITI courses are one of two requirement components needed to obtain the RCR Certificate to satisfy federal regulations that require RCR training as a part of grant and contracts terms and conditions.

- NOTE: These RCR courses are not completed in lieu of the basic courses in human subjects or lab animal welfare.

- The username(s) or member ID(s) for the account(s) to merge.




If you are not a registered user visit the <a>CITI website: select REGISTER






- Choose "Register" and type "Davis" or "University of California, Davis" to "Select Your Organization Affiliation."
- Read the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy and select AGREE if you agree to the terms.




- Click on "Create CITI Program Account"
- Type your personal information, (please use your UC Davis email) and continue to step 3.






Create your Username and Password.
 NOTE: UC Davis does not track passwords.




- Select your country of residence

- (If you say yes and allow CITI to contact you, you may receive marketing emails.) Select Finalize Registration.






Next you are asked about your CE credit status. CE Credit is not relevant to RCR courses.

Live Zoom Modules offered by the University of California, Davis

In addition to the required CITI modules, you are required to attend live Zoom sessions.

No registration for the live Zoom session is required. <u>Participants must join the session using a valid UC Davis NetID.</u>

Certificate of Completion

- The minimum passing score is 80% on each module. You may retake the quiz from any module that you did not pass.
- Once successful completion of the required CITI course, and your live Zoom attendance requirement is met, notify <u>eschase@ucdavis.edu</u> to request your RCR Certificate. Once verified, it will be sent to your UC Davis email address.
- Certificates are completed once a month at the end of the month in which all requirements are completed.
